

PLANT CARE GUIDE

AGLAONEMA COMMUTATUM

(a-glah-oh-NEE-ma com-mu-TAY-tum)

COMMON NAMES:

Chinese Evergreen, Pewter Plant

FAMILY: Araceae

ORIGIN: Subtropical Asia

GROWTH	Large, bushy
LIGHT	Low
WATER	Allow to dry partially
HUMIDITY	30% +
TEMPERATURE	18°C - 26°C
SOIL	Regular potting mix
CONTAINER	Self-watering planters, living walls, atrium beds
NUTRIENTS	15-10-10 Monthly in Spring & Summer
PROPAGATION	Seed or division
INTERIORESCAPE USE	Shaded areas, air-purification
COMMON PESTS	Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

COMMON ISSUES	Root rot when overwatered, leaf necrosis in areas with a draft.
COMMENTS	Tolerant of many conditions. Can remove air pollutants such as formaldehyde and/or benzene often found in cigarette smoke from interior environments. Hundreds of different cultivars and varieties.
TOXICITY	Animals may display the following symptoms: struggle to swallow, irritation and swelling of the mouth, may vomit, foam at the mouth, and excess drooling. Only poisonous when large amounts are consumed.
