

PLANT CARE GUIDE

ALOE SP. "PINK BLUSH"

(al-oh)

COMMON NAMES:

Pink Blush Aloe

FAMILY: Aloeaceae

ORIGIN: South Africa

GROWTH	Clumping
LIGHT	Full sun
WATER	When completely dry
HUMIDITY	Not required
TEMPERATURE	18°C +
SOIL	Cactus mix
CONTAINER	Wide planter with drainage
NUTRIENTS	10-5-5 Monthly in Spring & Summer
PROPAGATION	Seed or removal of offsets
INTERIOIRSCAPE USE	Desktop, Desert-themed atrium
COMMON PESTS	Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

COMMON ISSUES	Root rot when overwatered. Leaves may break inside causing a drooping look.
COMMENTS	Very interesting looking Aloe plant. Perfect for succulent collectors! An artistically coloured cultivar with soft colours and a pink hue.
TOXICITY	Non-toxic and safe
