ANTHURIUM ANDRAEANUM

(an-THEWR-ree-um an-dree-AH-num)

COMMON NAMES:

Flamingo Flower, Tailflower, Laceleaf

FAMILY: Araceae

ORIGIN: Columbia

GROWTH	Clumping
LIGHT	Filtered
WATER	Evenly moist. Use only chlorine- free water
HUMIDITY	50% +
TEMPERATURE	16°C - 26°C
SOIL	Well-aerated, <mark>yet</mark> moist, potting mixture. Can be plante <mark>d in</mark> soilless mixtures
Container	Self-watering <mark>pl</mark> anter, living walls
Nutrients	10-15-10 when in flower
Propagation	Seed or splitting
Interiorscape Use	Adds colour to any area
COMMON PESTS	Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

COMMON ISSUES	Root rot when overwatered.
COMMENTS	One of the longest lasting blooms in the world. Flowers come in many colours and shapes, and other species are grown solely for their foliage.
TOXICITY	All parts of the plant are poisonous through dermatitis, ingestion, and eye irritant. Symptoms may include: Irritation of mouth and digestive symptoms if ingested; irritation of skin and eyes following contact with sap.
